

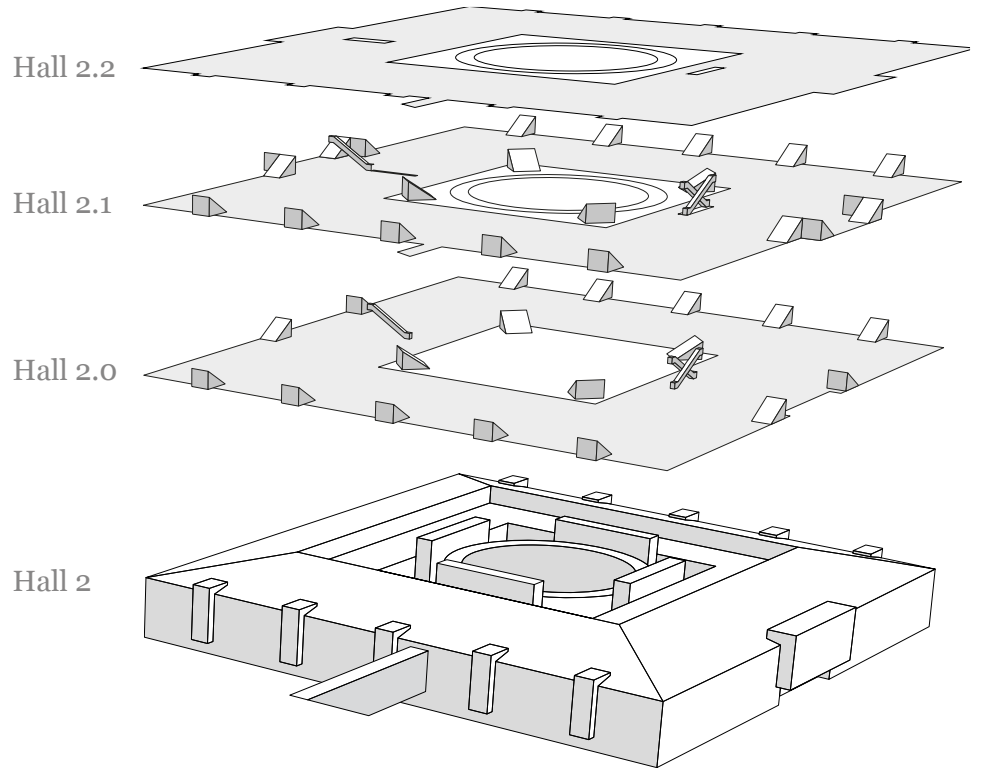


## Hall 2

Hall 2 bears the distinctive emblem of Messe Basel: the big clock on the glass front above the main entrance. And the eye-catching feature inside the Hall is the architecturally unique open circular courtyard with its galleries. This provides the perfect setting for events of all types that are accompanied by open-air activities.

Thanks to the open courtyard, all three storeys of Hall 2 benefit from a great deal of daylight and have a spacious feel to them. Hall 2 is linked to Hall 1 via a walkway.
